## WHAT KIND OF HELP DOES WORK GIVE?

- **Supported Employment Services:** Helps you keep your job.
- **Personal Assistance Services (PAS):** Get someone to help you with daily things like getting dressed or cooking.
- **Rides:** Get help getting to work or where you need to go.
- **Assistive Technology (AT):** Helps you in your everyday life. they can help you get medical equipment, a ramp, or other things to help you have a job.
- **Independent Living Counseling:** Helps you find services and supports in your community to live independently.
